Agenda:

- Parks may have an outhouse in stock available for Paradise Lake (Deception Lake). The club has asked for one over the years so that one is available for our Poker Ride events (lady riders) and riders just doing the Dome Loop for the day. Parks has asked whether we would also look after it? They would give us the required supplies for it if the club checked on it occasionally. The membership agreed we would check on it when riding the Dome Loop but we would not designate a specific person or have scheduled cleaning. We will have to see if Parks accepts this offer. The question was asked if the SSA would be using the outhouse as well? If so, it may need to be built up on a platform to compensate for snow depth. This will need to be discussed with Parks and the SSA as snow depth is not a concern for our usage. The SSA is in favor of sharing the kiosk with the club. Parks has been advised and we will wait to see if they have a large kiosk that can be installed at the Dome Parking Lot. Members were in favor of having a large trail map placed on the kiosk with mile markers and highlights of the Dome Trail. A warning that no Jeeps or trucks are allowed on the meadow boardwalks and a width precaution of 6 feet so that larger SXS are aware before accessing.

Old Business 2024

- Dome Trail; the trail erosion problem was dealt with in 2024 by DWB Consulting of Smithers. This section of trail will need to be monitored for root clearing as the trail breaks in and roots become exposed under the alpine terrain. Anyone riding through the area once the snow pack recedes, is asked to please let me know what (if any) unsafe conditions were found so plans can be made to remedy deficiencies asap. I rode to km 5.3 on trail lots of snow there, went to bottom of switch backs on backside trail was good but did not go up switch backs.
- Microwave Trail, snow was encountered at 8 km from parking at bottom.
- Jonas Creek Rec Site was in great shape, clean and well maintained. Not sure how many club members stop to check the site but for those that do. THANK YOU!!
- Courtney Griffis is now head of the lottery for the Starr and Grizzly Plateau. Courtney has told us that they are working on a 2 km “Buffer Zone” from the trail into the Starr and if the Caribou are outside of the “Buffer” the ride will go ahead.
- Prospective dates we are looking at are: August 9th Grizzly Plateau, August 10th Grizzly Plateau, July 19th Starr Basin, August 16th Starr Basin, September 13th Starr Basin. These are proposed dates, we do not get all of them we will need to discuss with Courtney before the list is finalized. Once finalized we will be able to take 12 machines in on our permit. Rides are for club members only and sign up will be fcfs. All riders must wear a helmet and people that are doubling on an atv must be on a “two-up machine” this is per ATVBC insurance rules. We will also require volunteers to lead the group and be the permit holder for the club. Volunteers???
